Bank of Communications, founded in 1908, is one of the largest banks in China. It was listed on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange in June 2005 and the Shanghai Stock Exchange in May 2007. Bank of Communications is #171 on the 2017 Fortune Global 500 list.

HNA Group is a Chinese conglomerate headquartered in Haikou, Hainan, China. Founded in 2000, it is involved in the aviation, real estate, financial services, tourism, logistics, and other industries. HNA Group was ranked 170th in 2017 Fortune Global 500 list.

Hisense is a Chinese multinational white goods and electronics manufacturer headquartered in Qingdao, China. It is a state-owned enterprise with publicly traded subsidiaries.

Dr. Yaoming Pei is the founder of Bright Pei Consulting. Holding an MBA degree from University of Illinois at Chicago, and a PhD degree from Illinois School of Professional Psychology, Dr. Pei was a Senior Consultant and Director at a professional human resource company. Bright Pei Consulting has successfully helped numerous international graduates to launch their own business in the Chicago area.

Dr. Weihua Zheng is cofounder and Vice President of Serionix. At Serionix, he and his team developed and launched NASA grade color changing air filters from R&D to full-scale production, and serving the market from aerospace, cleanrooms, to automotives and residential. Since founded in 2011, Serionix has received over \$4M funds from Private investment and government awards, who was also the winner of 2012 Cozad competition, and student startup award at Champaign Innovation Celebration.
