



Internship Opportunity: Site Design Landscape Architecture

Deadline for application: February 10, 2007, or until filled

Availability: Full-time summer (37 work hours, 3 instructional hours per week) *

Rate: Internship includes room and board plus a \$3,000 stipend.

Requirements: Minimum of two years of college course work in architecture, landscape architecture, or related field and/or related work experience.
Student must provide own transportation.
Must be able to perform rigorous physical activity.

Responsibilities

- Study pedestrian and vehicular traffic patterns throughout the core areas of Allerton Park to determine signage and way-finding needs
- Work with OCE Marketing Department to design an attractive, uniform and functional signage system that enhances the visitor experience
- Develop a project budget and timeline
- Install signage and way-finding materials throughout park

Student will learn:

- To assess organizational needs that relate to proposed project
- Principles of pedestrian and vehicular traffic movement
- Graphic design skills
- Project estimation and budgeting
- Project scheduling and construction skills
