

How IB Curriculum Revisions Affect Students at Different Stages:

- 1) Incoming freshman for Fall 2007: follow all newly revised curriculum.

- 2) Non-declared IB major as of Fall 2007, but subsequently become IB major:
If **have taken IB 201**, then IB 204 (Genetics) and IB 302 (Evolution) are NOT required.
However, must choose 14-18 hrs of Additional Courses according to the updated lists of Area Courses and Approved List of Additional Courses.

If **have NOT taken IB 201**, then take IB 204 (Genetics) and IB 302 (Evolution).
Also, must choose 14-18 hrs of Additional Courses according to the updated lists of Area Courses and Approved List of Additional Courses.

- 3) Declared IB majors as of Fall 2007
If **have taken IB 201**, then IB 204 (Genetics) and IB 302 (Evolution) are NOT required.
However, must choose 14-18 hrs of Additional Courses according to the updated lists of Area Courses and Approved List of Additional Courses.

If **have NOT taken IB 201**, then take IB 204 (Genetics) and IB 302 (Evolution).
Also, must choose 14-18 hrs of Additional Courses according to the updated lists of Area Courses and Approved List of Additional Courses.
